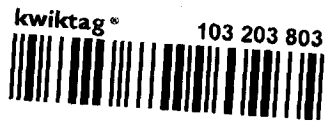



D.C. LAW 8-123

"Guardianship and Protective Proceedings
Amendment Act of 1990".

Pursuant to Section 412 of the District of Columbia Self-Government and Governmental Reorganization Act, P. L. 93-198, "the Act", the Council of the District of Columbia adopted Bill No. 8-387 on first and second readings, February 13, 1990, and February 27, 1990, respectively. Following the signature of the Mayor on March 15, 1990, this legislation was assigned Act No. 8-176, published in the March 30, 1990, edition of the D.C. Register, (Vol. 37 page 2085) and transmitted to Congress on March 22, 1990 for a 30-day review, in accordance with Section 602(c)(1) of the Act.

The Council of the District of Columbia hereby gives notice that the 30-day Congressional Review Period has expired, and therefore, cites this enactment as D.C. Law 8-123, effective May 15, 1990.

AN ACT

D.C. ACT 8 - 176

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

MAR 15 1990

To amend the District of Columbia Guardianship, Protective Proceedings and Durable Power of Attorney Act of 1986 to allow the court to waive the appointment of an examiner or visitor.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this act may be cited as the "Guardianship and Protective Proceedings Amendment Act of 1990".


Sec. 2. Section 21-2054(a) of the District of Columbia Code is amended to read as follows:


Section
21-2054

"(a) Upon receipt of a petition for appointment of a conservator or other protective order, the court shall set a date for a hearing. Unless the individual to be protected has chosen counsel, the court shall appoint an attorney to represent the individual. Except where the incapacity is alleged to be by disappearance or detention by a foreign power, the court may appoint an appropriately qualified examiner who shall submit a written report to the court. Except where the incapacity is alleged to be by disappearance or detention by a foreign power or someone other than a foreign power, the court may appoint a visitor who shall submit a written report to the court. If an examiner and a visitor are appointed for an individual, the examiner and visitor shall be separate persons."

Sec. 3. This act shall take effect after a 30-day period of Congressional review following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the Mayor, action by the Council of the District of Columbia to override the veto) as provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Self-Government and Governmental Reorganization Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Code, sec. 1-233(c)(1)), and publication in either the District of Columbia Register, the District of Columbia

Sec. 5. This act shall take effect upon its enactment (approval by the Mayor, or in the event of veto by the Mayor, override of the veto by the Council) and shall remain in effect for no longer than 90 days, as provided for emergency acts of the Council of the District of Columbia in section 412(a) of the District of Columbia Self-Government and Governmental Reorganization Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 788; D.C. Code, sec. 1-229(a)).
