D.C. LAW 6-205

"Lottery Initiative No. 6 Reform Amendment Act of 1986".

Pursuant to Section 412 of the District of Columbia Self-Government and Governmental Reorganization Act, P. L. 93-198, "the Act", the Council of the District of Columbia adopted Bill No. 6-526 on first and second readings, November 18, 1986 and December 16, 1986, respectively. Following the signature of the Mayor on January 8, 1987, this legislation was assigned Act No. 6-265, published in the January 30, 1987, edition of the D.C. Register, (Vol. 34 page 670) and transmitted to Congress on January 13, 1987 for a 30-day review, in accordance with Section 602 (c)(1) of the Act.

The Council of the District of Columbia hereby gives notice that the 30-day Congressional Review Period has expired, and therefore, cites this enactment as D.C. Law 6-205, effective February 28, 1987.

D.C. ACT 6 - 265

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To amend the District of Columbia Government Comprehensive Merit Personnel Act of 1978 to make the Executive Director and Deputy Director of the District of Columbia Lottery and Charitable Games Control Board ("Board") statutory office holders in the Excepted Service, to make the Board the personnel authority for the Executive Director and Deputy Director of the Board, to make the Executive Director the personnel authority for all other employees of the Board, and to permit the Board to have a maximum of 6 positions that may be filled by Excepted Service appointments; and to amend the Law to Legalize Lotteries, Daily Numbers Games, and Bingo and Raffles for Charitable Purposes in the District of Columbia to permit the Board to appoint an Executive Director and Deputy Director in the Excepted Service, to fix the rates of compensation for the Executive Director and Deputy Director, and to define some of the duties of the Executive Director.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA,
That this act may be cited as the "Lottery Initiative No. 6
Reform Amendment Act of 1986".

- Sec. 2. The District of Columbia Government

 Comprehensive Merit Personnel Act of 1978, effective March

 3, 1979 (D.C. Law 2-139; D.C. Code, sec. 1-601.1 et seq.),

 is amended as follows:
- (a) Section 406(b) (D.C. Code, sec. 1-604.6(b)) is $\begin{array}{c} \text{D.C. Code, s} \\ 1-604.6 \end{array}$ amended by adding a new paragraph (13) to read as follows: supp.)

- "(13) For the Executive Director and Deputy
 Director of the District of Columbia Lottery and Charitable
 Games Control Board ("Board"), the personnel authority is
 the Board, and for all other employees of the Board the
 personnel authority is the Executive Director of the
 Board.".
- (b) Section 903(a) (D.C. Code, sec. 1-610.3(a)) is D.C. Code, secantly amended by adding a new paragraph (6a) to read as follows: Supp.)
- "(6a) The District of Columbia Lottery and
 Charitable Games Control Board ('Board') may appoint 6
 persons who report directly to either the Executive Director
 or Deputy Director, or who head major units of the Board.".
- (c) Section 908 (D.C. Code, sec. 1-610.8) is amended New, D.C. Cod sec. 1-610.8 by adding a new subsection (m) to read as follows: (1987 supp.)
- "(m) The Executive Director and Deputy Director of the District of Columbia Lottery and Charitable Games Control Board.".
- Sec. 3. Section 2-2503 of section 4 of the Law to
 Legalize Lotteries, Daily Numbers Games, and Bingo and
 Raffles for Charitable Purposes in the District of Columbia,
 effective March 10, 1981 (D.C. Law 3-172; D.C. Code, sec.
 2-2503), is amended to read as follows:

"Section 2-2503. Executive Director and Deputy

[&]quot;(a) The Board shall appoint an Executive Director and

a Deputy Director in accordance with section 908 of the District of Columbia Government Comprehensive Merit Personnel Act of 1978, effective March 3, 1979 (D.C. Law 2-139; D.C. Code, sec. 1-610.8), each of whom shall devote his or her full-time and attention to the duties of their respective offices and shall serve at the pleasure of the Board.

- "(b) The Board shall determine the compensation for the Executive Director and the Deputy Director, which shall not be less than the basic pay for step 1 of Grade 16 of Schedule 1 of the District Service Schedule, nor shall it exceed the rate of compensation for the Mayor of the District of Columbia pursuant to section 1109 of the District of Columbia Government Comprehensive Merit Personnel Act of 1978, effective March 3, 1979 (D.C. Law 2-139; D.C. Code, sec. 1-612.9).
- "(c) Prior to performing the duties of their respective offices, the Executive Director and the Deputy Director shall take and subscribe to the same oaths or affirmations as that required by the Board, including an oath or affirmation that he or she is not primarily interested, directly or indirectly, in any firm, partnership, association, organization, or corporation engaged in any activity related to legalized or illegal gambling. The Executive Director and the Deputy Director

shall each file an annual financial disclosure statement with the Board.

- "(d) The Executive Director shall, subject to the direction and supervision of the Board:
- "(1) Serve as the Chief Executive Officer of the Board;
- "(2) Manage, administer, and coordinate the operation of public gambling and charitable games activities;
- "(3) Employ other assistants and employees in accordance with the District of Columbia Government Comprehensive Merit Personnel Act of 1978, effective March 3, 1979 (D.C. Law 2-139; D.C. Code, sec. 1-601.1 et seq.); and
- "(4) Confer, at least once each month, with the Board on the administration and operation of public gambling and charitable games activities.
- "(e) The Board may delegate to the Executive Director and Deputy Director other duties it deems necessary for the proper and efficient operation of public gambling and charitable activities.".
- Sec. 4. This act shall take effect after a 30-day period of Congressional review following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the Mayor, action by the Council of the District of Columbia to override the veto) as

provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Self-Government and Governmental Reorganization Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Code, sec. 1-233(c)(1)).
